- Livestock production is vitally important for Europe's future (€130 billion to the EU economy 35% of the agricultural sector, employment for nearly 30 million people).
- In a world with more people, can afford to consume more animal based proteins (in 2050, more than 9 billion people will consume 2 times more meat, dairy and eggs).
- With grand societal challenges regarding environmental footprint, animal welfare and ecosystem services
- Requiring new integrated approaches for optimal use of produced biomass in a circular biobased economy




Year 2015 Precision Livestock Farming in Practice






