Goals Sustainable herd

The health, welfare and productivity of the herd are in the forefront of efforts to increase the sustainability of food production. CRV's aim for 2020 is to provide farmers with bulls they can use to **breed a herd that is naturally healthier** with cows that live for one extra year. The result will include:

Goals sustainable herd:	
Healthier udders, reduction in cases of mastitis	10%
Healthier legs and claws, reduction in incidence of leg problems	10%
Cleaner milk production, reduction in CO2 emmissions per kilo of milk	10%
Cleaner beef production, reduction in CO ₂ emmissions per kilo of beef	5%
Animals milking for longer, increase of lifetime production	30%
Better feed utilisation:	
- reduction in feed use per kilo of milk	10%
- reduction in feed use per kilo of beef	5%
