- Shared and up-to-date view on Agri&Food 2025
 - Anticipate on trends in (inter)national markets and local society
 - Explicit for different livestock sectors
- Suitable conditions for dynamic networks and entrepreneurship
 - ‘safety zones’ and ‘connectors’ for all livestock sectors
 - Participants ‘golden triangle’ have the willingness to support innovators
- Availability basic knowledge infrastructure
 - Technical innovations and social skills
- Golden triangle or triple helix
 - Industry, university/institutes, government (and ngo's)
- Availability public and private funds
 - All processes - R&D, synthesis, implementation - of innovation cycle
