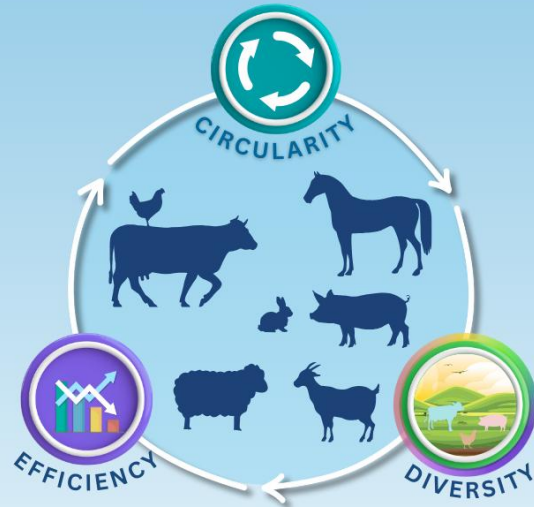

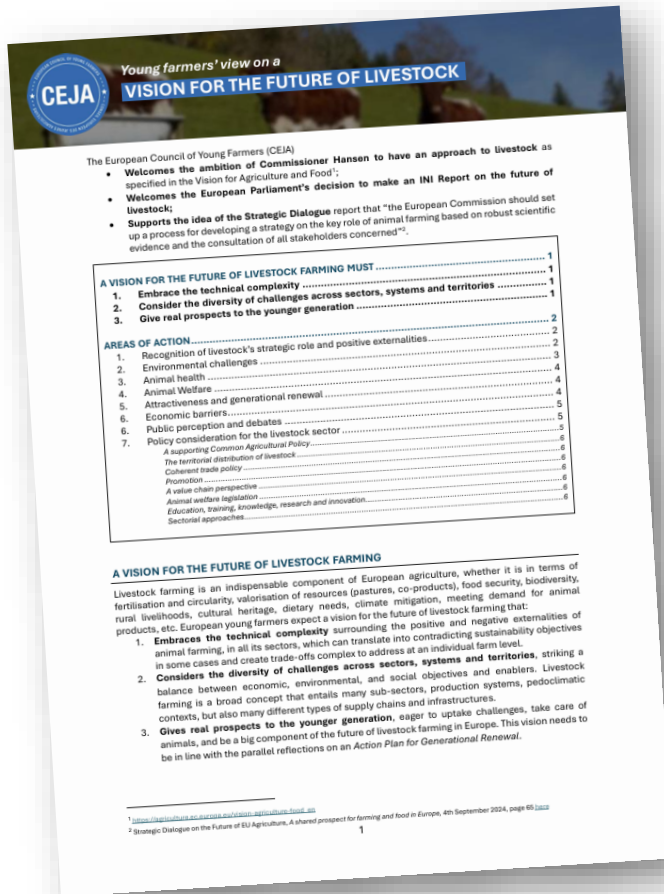

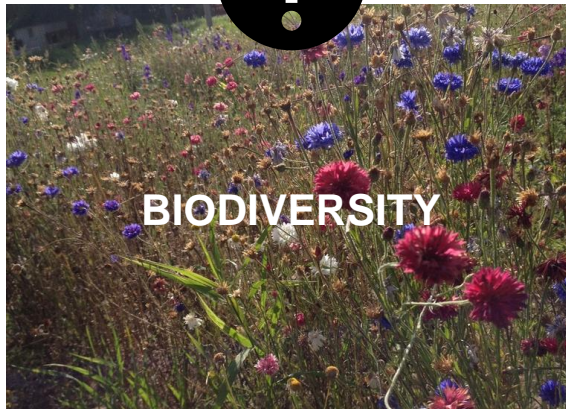

3 Generational renewal - giving real prospects to the younger generation

*Entrepreneurship; access to land; access to credit;
work-life balance; rural areas, knowledge...*



- **Specific support for young farmers** (CAP; Strategy for generational renewal...)
- Ensuring a positive, inclusive and fact-based **perception of livestock sectors**, impacting individual projects, willingness of financial actors...
- **Stabilise income and manage risks**, specific reflection for livestock (e.g. market volatility; the increasing problems with animal diseases...)
- **Sectorial analysis** of generational renewal in precise sectors.
- **Enhanced educational efforts**
- **Reflections on concrete improvements to quality of life** (farm relief..)
