

- Ensuring a positive, inclusive and fact-based <u>perception</u> of livestock sectors, impacting individual projects, willingness of financial actors...
- **Stabilise income and manage risks,** specific reflection for livestock (e.g. market volatility; the increasing problems with animal diseases...)
- Sectorial analysis of generational renewal in precise sectors.
- Enhanced educational efforts
- Reflections on concrete improvements to quality of life (farm relief..)
